

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how SYMM Ltd. (“SYMM”, “Symmetry Fund”, “Company”, “we” or “us”) collects, stores, uses and protects personal information. You accept this Privacy Policy when you use SYMM’s services or any other features, technologies or functionalities offered by SYMM on SYMM’s website or through any other means. The Terms of Token Sale (hereinafter as the “**Terms**”) and Privacy Policy (hereinafter also as the “**Policy**”) is a single set of rules which regulates the relationships between you, the Purchaser (as is set in the Terms), and SYMM, therefore the Terms and this Privacy Policy constitute an inseparable parts of the sole and unified agreement (hereinafter as the “Agreement”). You cannot accept it the partially, this set of rules should be accepted in full. SYMM cannot comply with the requirements of all jurisdictions worldwide while doing business. 1. INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

We may collect and process the following data about you:

- information that you may provide by filling in forms and registration forms on the Website in respect of assignment of the claim, registration application. This includes information provided at the time when you complete an online Registration application;
- information obtained from you or from third parties;
- details of transactions you carry out through the Website;
- correspondence and records of all contact with you, including any discussions. Please note that calls between us may be recorded and/or monitored;
- surveys that we use for research purposes, which we have asked you to complete, although you are under no obligation to respond to them.

2. HOW WE COLLECT AND USE YOUR INFORMATION

We use information held about you in the following ways (when register on the Website, the details you enter will be stored and used):

- to verify your identity;
- to notify you about changes to our products and services.
- to contact you about our products and services that may be of interest to you.

- to pass to third party companies (provided you have given express consent for the us to do so) who may contact you about products and services that may be of interest to you.

Every time we contact you for marketing purposes we will give you the opportunity to opt-out of receiving further marketing materials. We may contact you by post, e-mail, SMS message or telephone.

We reserve the right to take reasonable steps to authenticate your identity with respect to any such request or other enquiry.

3. WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

All information you provide us to us is, as far reasonably practicable, stored on our secure servers to protect against the unauthorized access, modification, destruction or disclosure of personal information. Any sensitive information, such as card numbers will be encrypted using secure socket layer technology (SSL) and/or Advanced Encryption Standard (AES-256) and/or other similar technologies. We ask you not to permit anyone to use your name. Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Website; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your personal data, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorized access. We will retain your information securely stored for a reasonable period or for as long as the law requires.
